

2018 STATE CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

The Chess Team will again compete at the PA State Scholastic Chess Championship on Mar. 3 & 4 at the Eisenhower Hotel & Conference Center in Gettysburg. (See pscfchess.org/pascholasticchamp for details.) It is an "open" tournament so everyone is eligible, even novices playing in their very first chess tournament. Playing chess with 500 other students can lead to a healthy, lifelong appreciation for a great game that's much better for your brain than Xbox. See our website at wyomissingchess.com for pictures of previous tournaments. We took second place in the whole state in 2007!

The top 9 active players in Chess Club are eligible to go with the school paying registration fees & providing van transportation. Students must pack their lunch, eat in the hotel snack bar or join Mr. Minich on a fast food run. Students without their own chess set or chess clock can borrow school equipment but there is a tournament store with good prices on chess gear that's important for serious chess players (sets from \$15 & clocks from \$30).

Please contact me to learn if you are in the top 9 active members or not. If you miss the deadline for turning in the permission slip, another member of Chess Club may take your spot!

Those who are **NOT** in the top 9 must also **turn in a check payable to "PSCF"** for an amount ranging from \$25 - 55 and arrange their own transportation. **Please contact Mr. Minich for details and your exact registration amount.** He will register everyone together under a combined team registration.
